Springfest The UC-sponsored May Day celebration, known colloquially as "Springfest", is a manifestation of the soft, ineffectual, individualistic notions typically advanced by the liberal elite. We must forge the College into a single, well-organized, morally pure organic whole. I propose that the UC replace the subversive ritual of "Springfest" with an annual People's Rally For The Community, or "Springfast". Standing attentively in well-drilled ranks, the students of the College will spend the day neither eating nor drinking, and listening to my exhortations to exert themselves fully for the greater glory of Harvard.
